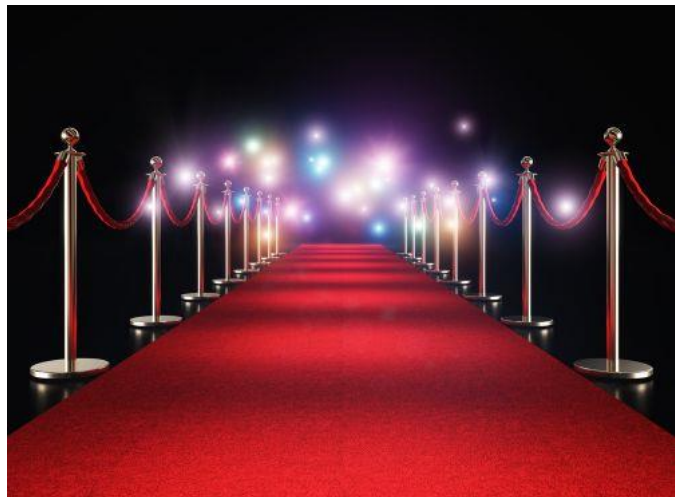

General Information

1. All NBTA rules are in effect. Twirling ages as of 9/01/24.
2. NBTA Judges will officiate, and judge's decisions are final.
3. Contestants must report to lanes on time. This will be done in a set system starting after marching. Please check at the beginning of the contest to make sure that there are no conflicts.
4. For the Beginner and Intermediate Pageants, the same costume needs to be worn for modeling and strut.
5. **DOUBLE ENTERING** – A contestant may double enter in open contests only and compete in a higher status level. Double entering is permitted only when the contestant also enters the contestant's true status level (Nov-Beg-Inter-Adv.) Caution: Competing at a higher status level without competing at current status level automatically advances the contestant to the higher level. Double entering is not permitted in State/Regional/National NBTA championship contests.
6. Smoking is not permitted on school grounds
7. The contest floor is reserved for contestants and officials only.
8. **If a competitor wins the pageant at Regionals the weekend before, they will receive a refund for the pageant only. There will be no other refunds.**
9. **No outside food. There will be concessions available. Please, no food or drinks other than water in the gyms.**
10. Courtland High School, the Spotsylvania High School Band Parents Associate, and the directors are not responsible for lost items or damage to personal property nor any type of injury at or incidental to contest.
11. Videotaping is **ONLY** allowed for **YOUR CHILDREN** or **STUDENT**. Please no flash photography for the safety of the students. **ALSO**, this includes no live streaming of any kind. There will be no videotaping directly in line of judging. Please use the designated areas.

Modeling Attire for the Advanced Miss Majorette of VA Pageant:

0-6 and 7-9 divisions – short party dress

10-12 – party dress, long or tea-length dress

13-15, 16+ and College – long or tea-length dress

***Miss Majorette of VA Interview: There will be a short interview with the judge after you model for the Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced Divisions. Novice does NOT interview.

All Contestants will be judged by the following criteria: Solo – 40%, Super X Strut – 40%, Modeling – 20%

Awards for Beginner Pageant Winner, Intermediate Pageant Winner and Miss Majorette of Virginia:

Novice: 1st Place medal and a banner

2nd through 5th place – Medal

1st Place in Solo, Strut & Modeling will each receive a ribbon

Beginner and Intermediate: 1 Place trophy (1 Place Winner is eligible to compete at AYOP in July 2025)

2nd through 5th place – trophies

1st Place in Solo, Strut & Modeling will each receive a ribbon or medal

Advanced: 1st place trophy and banner (1st -3rd Place Winners are eligible to compete at AYOP in July 2025)

2nd through 5th place – Trophies

1st Place in Solo, Strut & Modeling will each receive a ribbon or medal

Collegiate: 1st place trophy and Banner. There will be a scholarship awarded for 1st in memory of Shelvy Manning

Open awards:

Novice: medals for places 1st – 5th

For others: 1st place trophies, 2nd -5th medals or trophies

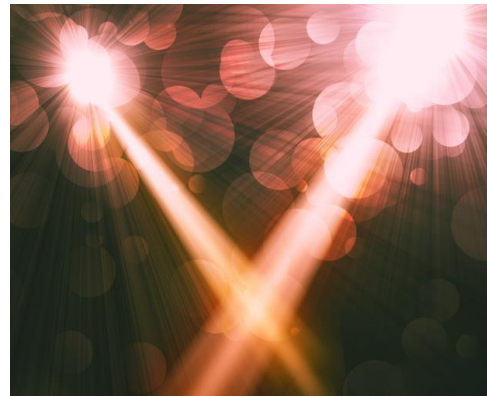
